Parade Application Fee

\$15 Application Fee is required for **EACH** entry. Floats, vehicles, motorcycles, team of horses (2 horses), tractors, golf carts, etc. – Various *Clubs* are limited to *20 participants* (see below for more info).

Upon completion of the application, signed waiver, and application fee, you will be given a number for the check in process for the day of the parade. You must have your designated number to be checked in properly and determine your place in the lineup.

Parade Application Fee Deadline

Noon – Wednesday, November 29th, 2023

Parade Application Fee Distribution

The Application Fee will go towards the Float Awards prize money, with the remaining collections going to Townsend Elementary School.

2023 Christmas Parade Theme

This year's theme is "Your Favorite Christmas Movie"

It is encouraged that parade float participants decorate and dress with the selected theme in mind, however, it is not a requirement.

Parade Rescheduling

The parade will take place regardless of the weather conditions (rain or shine) unless you are otherwise notified.

Awards

1st, 2nd and 3rd place awards will be given for the Float Category only

1 st Place - \$200

2nd Place - \$100

3rd Place - \$50

The City of Townsend Board of Commissioners will be judging the floats before the parade. Please be sure to clarify on your application if you are entering a float for the contest. Floats need to be checked in no later than 1 o'clock.

Award Winners

The Float award winners will be announced before the start of the parade with magnets to put on your unit to show during the parade. Magnets must be returned to Townsend City Hall in order to receive your prize money.

Parade Decorating Guidelines

• All parade entries must use Christmas themes and decorations

- <u>No</u> "Santa" or "Santa Claus" costumes are allowed in your entry. Anyone that has "Santa" on their entry will not be allowed in the parade. The "*Parade Santa*" will be making an appearance at the end of the parade and we do not want to confuse the children in attendance
- All entries should decorate so that viewing is equally appealing from both sides
- The City of Townsend is a family-friendly event for all ages, and every entry is expected to respect this. All decorations, costumes, etc. must be appropriate for a young audience
- No real fire, bullhorns or air horns
- If portable generators are used, they must be securely mounted on a vehicle and located away from any combustible materials
- No political messages are permitted in the parade
- All entries are subject to a safety inspection

Parade Rules and Restrictions

Time

Check-in time is at 12:00 PM. Please do not show up to check-in at the last second. Parade workers need time to check you in and get your entry staged properly.

Participant Spacing

No entries will be allowed to stop during the parade, except when necessary. You must keep the parade moving at all times. Stopping and socializing with parade spectators is not allowed. Each entry shall maintain a safe distance from the entry in front of them, while at the same time not allowing gaps to form between them.

Code of Conduct

Participating in the parade in no way releases anyone from observing all laws and regulations. Please keep in mind that this is a family-friendly event. Individuals and organizations are expected to be courteous to parade officials, attendees, and all other participants. Bad language and fighting will NOT be tolerated. **Smoking or drinking alcohol is not permitted in the parade line-up or at any time during the parade.**

Motor Vehicle (Car, motorcycle, four-wheeler, go kart, etc.) Drivers

All participants driving motor vehicles, motorcycles, four-wheelers, golf carts, tractors, **MUST** sign the entry form as a waiver, and provide proof of driver's license when applying.

Horse Riders

All participants riding horses MUST sign the entry form as a waiver.

Horses are allowed, but they are **REQUIRED** to wear an equine diaper. The expectation is that you clean up after your horse. If you do not have your horse in an equine diaper, you must have someone picking up after them before, during and after the parade. **If you do not pick up after them, you will be asked to not participate in our parade.** Horses are **not allowed** on the bike trail.

Club Members (Motor Vehicle Participants)

If you are part of a club (cars, motorcycles, four-wheelers, golf carts, tractors, etc.) please have your **top 20 participants** entered in the parade. This is in an attempt to reduce the parade length and resulting road closure time.

Please note that each entrant will still need to pay their own \$15 application fee.

Distribution of Materials

Candy, samples, or materials may be distributed as a participant travels the parade route. Participants are responsible for purchasing their own candy, the City of Townsend will not be providing items to distribute.

Please ensure that when throwing out candy and other items, it is done in a smart and safe manner as to not allow children to be put in harms way while they are picking up items off the roadway.

Music and Band Units

Music should be complementary to the entry and not disruptive. Parade officials have the right to control the volume level coming from each entry.

We ask that if you are placed close to the band in the parade line-up, please let them play their music and do not disrupt their performance.

Dogs

Dogs are allowed. They may be placed on a float or inside a vehicle.

If walking as part of the parade, dogs shall be on a leash and walk with the designated dog group.

Please keep animals in control, otherwise they will be asked to be removed.

All Vaccinations need to be up to date for your dog.

Vendors

Any vendor must follow the regular permit rules in place and have the approval of the City of Townsend Board of Commissioners prior to the parade.

In Case of Emergency

In the event of an emergency, please follow the direction of your closest police officer/parade official.
